

Book 2 – DISCOVERY 1

Proverbs 17:17 A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity.

Psalm 78:4 We will not hid them (God's words) from our children; we will tell the next generation of the praiseworthy deed of the LORD, His power, and the wonders He has done.

Psalm 145:4 One generation will commend Your works to another, they will tell of Your mighty acts.

John 14:2 In My Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you.

John 1:12 Yet to all who received Him, to those who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God.

Book 2 – DISCOVERY 3

2 Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Psalm 95:6 Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the LORD our Maker.

Psalm 100:2 Worship the LORD with gladness, come before Him with joyful songs.

Ephesians 6:18 And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.

1 Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.

A: Church is a place where we can encourage each other.

1 Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.

Hebrews 3:13 But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness.

Book 2 – DISCOVERY 4

Q: Why should I go to church?

A: *Church is a place where I can make Christian friends.*

Hebrews 10:24-25 And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Q: Why should I go to church?

A: *Church is a place where I can serve.*

1 Timothy 4:12 Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in love, in faith, and in purity.

Titus 2:7a In everything set them an example by doing what is good.

Q: Why should I go to church?

A: *Church is a place where I can give my offering.*

2 Corinthians 9:7 Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

James 1:17a Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of heavenly lights.

Q: Why should I go to church?

A: *Church is a place where I can remember Christ's death and resurrection in a special way.*

Luke 22:19-20 And He took bread, gave thanks, and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of Me." In the same way, after the supper He took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is poured out for you."

Book 2 – DISCOVERY 5

Q: How can I help other people?

A: *I can love others as God loves me.*

1 John 4:10-11, 21 This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. And He has given us this command: Whoever loves God must also love his brother.

Q: How can I help other people?

A: *I can put their needs before my own.*

Philippians 2:3 Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves.

1 John 3:16 This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down His life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers.

Q: How can I help other people?

A: *I can encourage other people.*

Proverbs 12:25b A kind word cheers him (a man) up.

Proverbs 16:24 Pleasant words are a honeycomb, sweet to the soul and healing to the bones.

Romans 15:2 Each of us should please his neighbor for his good, to build him up.

Q: How can I help other people?

A: *I can be patient with other people.*

1 Thessalonians 5:14 And we urge you, brothers, warn those who are idle, encourage the timid, help the weak, be patient with everyone.

James 1:19 My dear brothers, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.

Book 2 – DISCOVERY 6

Q: How can I help other people?

A: *I can do good to those around me.*

Luke 6:31 Do to others as you would have them do to you.

Galatians 6:10 Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.

1 Timothy 6:18 Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share.

Q: How can I help other people?

A: *I can reach out beyond my community.*

Acts 1:8 “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

2 Corinthians 5:20 We are therefore Christ’s ambassadors, as though God were making His appeal through us. We implore you on Christ’s behalf: Be reconciled to God.

Q: How can I help other people?

A: *I can be a missionary to people around me.*

Mark 1:17 “Come, follow Me,” Jesus said, “and I will make you fishers of men.”

Romans 10:15b How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!

Q: How can I help other people?

A: *I can pray for others.*

1 Timothy 2:1-3 I urge, then, first of all that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone. For kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior.

Book 2 – DISCOVERY 7

Q: What do I need to know about Satan, angels and the future?

A: *Satan is an angel who sinned against God.*

Isaiah 14:13,15 You (Satan) said in your heart, “I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God; I will sit enthroned on the mount of assembly, on the utmost heights of the sacred mountain.” But you are brought down to the grave, to the depths of the pit.

Q: What do I need to know about Satan, angels and the future?

A: *Satan will be punished forever when Jesus returns.*

Revelation 20:10 And the devil, who deceived them, was thrown into the lake of burning sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet had been thrown. They will be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Hebrews 2:14b That by His death He (Christ) might destroy him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil.

Q: What do I need to know about Satan, angels and the future?

A: *Angels are heavenly beings created by God.*

Job 38:6-7 On what were its footings set, or who laid its cornerstone—while the morning stars sang together and all the angels shouted for joy?

Nehemiah 9:6 You alone are the LORD. You made the heavens, even the highest heavens, all the starry host, the earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them. You give live to everything, and the multitudes of heaven worship You.

Q: What do I need to know about Satan, angels and the future?

A: *Angels serve God.*

Psalms 103:20-21 Praise the LORD, you His angels, you mighty ones who do His bidding, who obey His word. Praise the LORD, all His heavenly hosts, you His servants who do His will.

Psalms 148:2 Praise Him, all His angels, praise Him, all His heavenly hosts.

Book 2 – DISCOVERY 8

Q: What do I need to know about Satan, angels and the future?

A: *I need to be ready for the return of the Lord Jesus Christ.*

1 John 2:28 And now, dear children, continue in Him, so that when He appears we may be confident and unashamed before Him at His coming.

1 Thessalonians 5:23 May God Himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Q: What do I need to know about Satan, angels and the future?

A: *The Lord Jesus will meet Christians in the air.*

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 For the Lord Himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever.

1 Thessalonians 5:6 So then, let us not be like others, who are asleep, but let us be alert and self-controlled.

Q: What do I need to know about Satan, angels and the future?

A: *The earth will go through seven years of tribulation.*

Revelation 3:10 Since you have kept My command to endure patiently, I will also keep you from the hour of trial that is going to come upon the whole world to test those who live on the earth.

Jeremiah 30:7 How awful that day will be! None will be like it. It will be a time of trouble for Jacob, but he will be saved out of it.

Q: What do I need to know about Satan, angels and the future?

A: *The Lord Jesus will reign on earth for 1,000 years.*

Revelation 20:6 Blessed and holy are those who have part in the first resurrection. The second death has no power over them, but they will be priest of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.
